Highlights of Sightseeing

Located at southwestern end of Japan, Ishigaki-jima is the main island of Yaeyama Islands. The Yaeyama islands possess excellent beaches, many snorkel and dive sites, and Japan's last untouched jungles. In this tour, you will have 3 different options (additional charge will apply to the tour price) on Day2 to enjoy the islands according to your taste.

Day1

When you fly into Ishigaki-jima on your own, you will depart for sightseeing tour of the main island by a chartered coach. Stop at Kabira Bay which is the top tourist site known for its transparent coral blue water with white-sand shores. Here you will enjoy a Glass Boat tour to watch coral reef and tropical fish underneath the boat.

Proceed to Yaima Village where you will encounter old houses of Ishigaki with red tiled roofs revived as a theme park. If time allows, you may join in cultural experiences (additional charge) such as fitting traditional costumes and painting colors on traditional "Shisa" (lion-like beasts considered as guardian).

At the end of the tour, visit Mineya Factory to watch the professional craftsman weaving traditional textiles called "Minsa-ori". Of course you will have some time to shop products of Minsa-ori for your souvenir.

Day2

Enjoy Islands of Paradise in 3 different options (additional charge) according to your taste.

Plan A- Unique Islands around (Full Day)

In this plan you will go through one of the biggest Mangrove forest in Japan along Nakama River by a Mangrove Cruise in Iriomote-jima. Subsequent 15 minute trip by Water Buffalo Carriage will bring you from Iriomote-jima to the small Yubu-jima. The sea is shallow to the distance and this carriage trip is just calm and peaceful. After lunch, enjoy free time at Taketomi-jima before going back to Ishigaki-jima.

Plan B- Snorkel and Dream Island (Full Day)

This plan focuses on beautiful islands and snorkeling. Panari Island is located 60 minutes away from Ishigaki-jima by ship. There used to be a habitat of dugongs and the transparency of the water is very much popular for snorkelers. After lunch, move to Dream Island which is called so as it totally disappears at high tide. It must be a valuable experience to land on this fantastic sand beach. There are no regular ship services to Panari Island or Dream Island and only accessible by a tour!

Plan C- Snorkel at Blue Cave (Half Day)

If you only want a half day tour and take some time to rest at hotel, this is the best plan. Enjoy snorkeling in blue colored sea watching coral reef and tropical fish around the cave. You will also explore inside the cave to look for fossils of coral and strange-shaped limestones. After standing under Arakawa Fall, go back to hotel and leisure for the rest of the day.

Day3

You will have free time until departure.

A chartered coach will bring you to the airport and return flight should be arranged on your own.

Specialty of the region

◆ Ishigaki Beef (not included in above itinerary)

Most of Japanese "Wagyu" such as Matsuzaka beef, Kobe beef and Maezawa beef actually originate in Ishigaki-jima and around. Calves born in Ishigaki-jima are forwarded to each places after 8 months to be fed and gained a brand name according to where they are bred. In Ishigaki-jima, rich sunshine and refreshing sea breeze help calves to avoid stress and what is more, abundant fresh green grass instead of hay makes calves grow bigger and tasty.
